WHAT IS LIHWAP?

The Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP) is a temporary emergency program to help low-income families pay overdue water bills.

To receive help...

- Apply starting February 1, 2022.
- You need to have an unpaid water bill.
- You can either rent or own your home.
- Must be in a Crisis situation.

Crisis situations include:

- Past-due water bills.
- Termination of utility service.
- Danger of having utility service termination (received notice that service will be shut off within the next 60 days).

How do I apply?

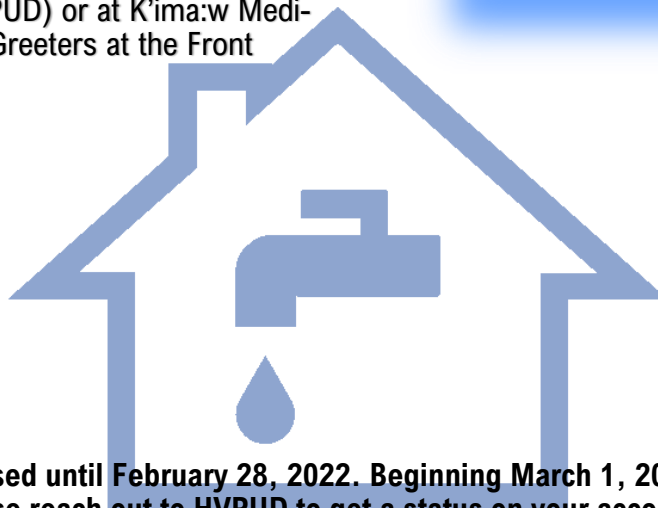
- Request an application by calling Sunshine Jackson at (530) 625-4261 ext. 0324 or by e-mail at Sunshine.jackson@kimaw.org.
- Applications are physically available at Hoopa Valley Public Utilities District (HVPUD) or at K'ima:w Medical Center (KMC) with the Greeters at the Front Lobby.

REQUIREMENTS FOR SERVICE:

- *Completed Application
- *Proof of Income—all household members for January 2022
 - *A recent water bill
- *Proof of Physical Address
- *Must be a Hoopa Tribal Member & reside on the Hoopa Valley Indian Reservation
- *Proof of Handicap/Disability (*only if claiming disability*)
- *Zero Income Verification form for all household members 18 and older that do not have any income, if any.



Crisis situations will be addressed until February 28, 2022. Beginning March 1, 2022 applications will be open for all tribal membership. Please reach out to HVPUD to get a status on your account and to see if you qualify.
